The Eleventh Day of February Two Thousand and Twenty

Pursuant to an Act of the Royal Court dated 24 January 2020, whereby it is ordered than an election for a Procureur du Bien Public be held in the Parish of St Peter, the term of office being due to expire March 2020.

A nomination was received for:

Mr Robert Philip Surcouf, of Mi-Roca Farm, La Rue des Niemes, St Peter was proposed by John Refault, seconded by Linda Garnier, Alan Dix, Martin Ball, Nicholas Le Luan, Graeme Pallot, Rodger Price, Julie Nolan, Susan Rive and Naomi Le Boutillier.

Mr Surcouf has lived in the Parish in Grande Vingtaine all his life. He is a Chartered Accountant and has worked in both fund and trust companies and specialised in corporate governance whilst at JTC Group.

He has his own enterprise risk consultancy firm and is developing regulatory technology as part of the local developing digital economy. He is a well-known face in husting and parish meetings and being an accomplished speaker he is ideally placed to become a Procureur du Bien Public for the parish but most importantly believes in the parish system.

As there were no further nominations, the Connetable congratulated Mr Surcouf, welcomed him to the parish and advised him to be available at the Royal Court for swearing in on **Friday 13 March 2020 at 10.00am**.
