1. On the proposition of **Joao Camara**, seconded by **Robert Surcouf**, the minutes of the previous parish assembly held on 10 November 2020, which had been previously handed out, were approved.

Robert Surcouf made apologies to the assembly for the absence of the senior Procureur Chris Benest who was unfortunately having to isolate.

2. Mr Ben Harvey addressed the assembly to advise that Strive Jersey Ltd wish to offer a small restaurant offering for lunchtimes and early evenings. They close at 6pm at the weekends and 8pm Monday to Friday so not planning any late licences.

The application was proposed by **William Dempsey**, who continued to advise that he has personally known Mr Harvey for 12 years. Mr Harvey is a Director of Strive who has spent the last 7 years trying to get the project up and running, many people thought it would not happen, but he always had faith in Ben. There are many things happening in the building, many offerings to children who have “Free” cards so the establishment need to make money in other areas, as more money, more free time they can offer to the children. In view of this he wishes them well. The application was seconded by **Clifford Chipperfield**.

The Chef de Police commented he has no objections to the application but enquired about the car park and any road widening schemes, Ben Harvey advised that they must change the current pathway to enable two people to walk along. He also confirmed they were planning to open May 2021.

All who attended that were able to vote were in favour, no objections, and no abstentions.

The Constable thanked everyone for attending.
