Meeting 260

Minutes for the Roads Committee Meeting held on Thursday 21 August at 5.00pm

Attended by Richard Vibert the Constable, Keith Capern, Paul Townsend, Martin Zimmer and Liz Cheetham the Parish Executive Officer .

Apologises from Rev R Harris.

- 1. Approve and sign minutes for meeting 259 .** The minutes were approved by KC and seconded by PT.
- 2. Budget :** Current budget shows a balance of £111,000 including wages. Main expenditure was £5,500 on resurfacing on Rue de la Hague. Good budget still for forthcoming items.
- 3. Branchage :** £350.00 in fines collected. Just waiting on an issue on Mont Des Charrieres to be completed but in hand. PT mentioned that there are a few areas that will need checking on the next Branchage.
- 4. Road works / potholes / Yellow lines/ Highway maintenance** Various potholes reported : Rue de Panigot, Rue du Coin Varin & near the 'German' road. Mont de la Mare. All marked ready for works. Signage as in painted signs also required.
Brought to attention that areas of 'Laybys' belonging to the parish are being used for parking so will contact relevant owners to advise them 'No Parking by order of the Constable' as under administration of the Roads Committee.
Mont Fondon- area of water running down and undermining property wall. Will look to clean and possibly place a filet in to assist with this.
- 5. Tree Matters-** Due to a tripping hazard, agreed for a Birch tree roots to be looked at within the grounds of Le Clos Le Ruez. LC to speak to our outdoor maintenance team.
When cars exiting from Rue des Vignes (Football club road) onto the main Airport Road, Elm suckers have created it difficult to see oncoming traffic. LC to write to SPGC and ask them to look at this.
- 6. Planning :** Potential conversion of La Sergente Farm. Roads Committee have no comment other than as long as the splay area is adequate then no issues /comments to make.
P/2025/0813- As the road is maintained by I&E, the Roads Committee cannot comment.
- 7. Speed limit changes ;** Update received from I&E; implementation of reduced speed limit signs have begun. Details on the website and also on the St Peters Residents Facebook page been seen. 30mph painted sign on La Rue des Presbytere needs blacking out ASAP as now incorrect. However, Once 2nd Branchage has been completed, will include any other signage issues then to the Contractor
- 8. Road Works Qualifications** Advise Committee of the new qualification being put in place by I&E with 4Safety whereas Companies and operatives that do works on the roads and use Trafficworx must go on the relevant courses available which comes into effect in January 2026. More details to be rolled out.
