Pursuant to an act of the Royal Court dated 09 January 2026, an Assembly of Electors was duly held in the Parish Hall on Tuesday 03 February 2026 to proceed with the Election of Procureur Du Bien Public

A nomination was received for :

Mr D'Anger has previously been a Roads Inspector for the Parish and with his financial background and has agreed to take on the role as Procureur Du Bien Public for the Parish.
