An Assembly of Principals and Electors of the Parish of St. Peter will be held in the Parish Hall on Tuesday 03 February 2026, at 7.15pm to: -

1. Receive, and if deemed advisable, approve the Act of the Parish Assembly held on Tuesday 09 December 2025.
2. Elect two Inspecteurs des Chemins for Grande Vingtaine for a period of three years, the term of office of the present holders having expired in December 2025.
3. Elect a Constables Officer for Grande Vingtaine for a period of three years.

1. On the proposal of **Alan Dix**, seconded by **Keith Capern**, the minutes of the Assembly held on the Ninth Day of December Two Thousand and Twenty-Five, which had been previously handed out, were approved.
2. **Peter Bisson** was nominated as a Roads Inspector for Grande Vingtaine by **Paul Townsend**, he has known Peter for over 30 years , great person and happy to propose. This was seconded by **Keith Capern**.
Glenys Bisson was nominated as a Roads Inspector for Grande Vingtaine by **Zoe Rive**, this was seconded by **Keith Capern**.

As there were no further nominations, the Constable stated his thanks to both Peter and Glenys who were absent from the assembly as off Island . This will be the first married couple to be Inspectors however both have assisted in the municipality in previous years.

They will be advised to attend court for swearing in accordingly.

3. A nomination for a Constables Officer for Grande Vingtaine was proposed by **Guy Carnegie** for **Rachel Ara** to take on the role, he has known Rachel for 5 years , she is very reliable , trustworthy and community driven, this was seconded by **Hannah Carnegie**.

As there were no further nominations, the Constable thanked Rachel for offering her assistance , its marvellous that people still wish to put their names forward. The police work is not always appreciated however the role is more professional now with more training .

Chef de Police Joao Camara also thanked Rachel for putting her name forward and looks forward to working together.
